Day 1 Mar 27**

Honolulu → Incheon

We start our vacation by boarding an international flight for Seoul, the capital of South Korea. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

Day 2 Mar 28**

Incheon

We arrive at Incheon International Airport where an Air and Sea Travel representative will greet us and transfer us to our hotel.

Day 3 Mar 29**

Incheon – Suwon – Mt. Seoraksan

(B, L, D)

This morning, we will transfer to Suwon to visit the KBS Film Studio, renowned for producing HD digital TV dramas. The studio features an open set, a drama production center, a special set, and various facilities. After lunch, we will head to Mt. Seoraksan, where the stunning cherry blossoms are in full bloom during April. Upon arrival, we will visit Daepohang Port, a bustling location that has become a popular destination for those seeking the freshest raw fish restaurants. After dinner, we will check into our hotel.

Day 4 Mar 30**

Mt. Seoraksan – Andong

(B, L, D)

Mt. Seoraksan offers breathtaking views and is home to over 2,000 animal species and more than 1,400 rare plant species. UNESCO Historical Site designated this national park a Biosphere Preservation District in 1982 and the park is the most famous national park in Korea. This morning, we will explore Mt. Seoraksan National Park, taking in the stunning cherry trees and flowers. We will ride the cable car to Gwongyeongseong Castle Ruins, where we can enjoy a panoramic view of the mountains. Following this, we will visit Sinheungsa Temple, where you'll find the impressive Great Bronze Statue, standing over 10 meters tall. After lunch, we will proceed to Andong, a market center that serves the surrounding agricultural areas.

Day 5 Mar 31**

Andong – Busan

(B, L, D)

After breakfast, we will visit Andong Hahoe Village, a traditional village dating back to the Joseon Dynasty and recognized as one of South Korea's most notable folk villages. Both Hahoe Village and Yangdong Folk Village are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Next, we will explore the Mask Museum, home to Korea's only mask designated as a national treasure. Here, we will have the opportunity to create our own paper masks. After lunch, we will visit the Andong Soju & Traditional Food Museum, where we will watch a demonstration on how to make Andong Soju and enjoy a tasting session. The museum also features traditional Korean cuisine from the Andong province. Following our visit, we will travel to Busan, South Korea's second-largest city and the largest port city in the country, ranking as the world's fifth-busiest seaport by cargo tonnage. Upon arrival, we will visit Jagalchi Fish Market, the largest fish market in Korea and a must-see destination for tourists in Busan. Located beside Nampo Port, the market ensures that fish remains fresh and is delivered quickly. After dinner, we will check into our hotel in Busan.

Day 6 Apr 1**

Day trip to Jinhae

(B)

After breakfast, we will have a day trip to Jinhae. Jinhae is famous for its annual Cherry Blossom Festival in South Korea and is the only place in the world where visitors can find more than 340,000 cherry blossoms in one city. The neighborhood turns white and pale pink during the annual cherry blossom festival period with the gentle breeze blowing about the petal-snowflakes. We can gaze at pale pink petals as they drift sentimentally down onto the train tracks of Gyeonghwa Station, or snap a picture at one of the most iconic spots to see cherry blossoms in Korea – Jinhae's Yeojwacheon Stream. We can enjoy our own lunch

here in the festival. We will then visit Jinhae Naval Academy. The Naval Academy is normally seen only through tours but is open to the public during the festival. Afterward, we will return to Busan and enjoy the dinner on our own nearby the hotel.

Day 7Apr 2**

Busan

(B, L)

After breakfast, we will visit Hyundai Motorstudio Busan, a state-of-the-art facility that showcases the brand's latest innovations in automotive technology and design. Located in the heart of Busan, this studio offers visitors an interactive experience that combines art, technology, and mobility. Then, we will visit the Instagram famous Gamcheon Culture Village. This village is formed by houses built in staircase-fashion on the foothills of a coastal mountain, earning this village the nickname "Machu Picchu of Busan." Many alleys that cut through this community are vibrantly decorated with murals and sculptures created by the residents. After lunch, we will return to hotel and enjoy the rest of day on our own.

Day 8Apr 3**

Busan – Seoul

(B, L)

After breakfast, we will transfer to the Busan KTX rail station to experience the KTX train ride, the fastest train in Korea. Upon arrival in Seoul, we will have the famous Ginseng Chicken Soup for lunch. Following our meal, we will transfer to our hotel for check-in. After settling in, we will visit Namdaemun Local Market, the largest and oldest wholesale market in Korea, where you can find a wide variety of goods at affordable prices. Enjoy some leisure shopping time in this vibrant market, conveniently located near our hotel. Tonight, you are free to explore and sample local Korean cuisine on your own.

Day 9Apr 4**

Day Trip to Nami Island

(B, L, D)

This morning, we will transfer to Nami Island just 70 kilometers north-east from Seoul. It is a popular, lovely, and romantic place for Koreans, especially during spring when the Cherry Blossoms are in bloom. Nami Island is often used as a filming site for well-known Korean dramas. After lunch, we will transfer to Seoul and visit Gangnam District. Starfield COEX Mall is one of the largest underground shopping centers in Asia. It features a wide range of shops, dining options, and entertainment facilities, including an aquarium and a movie theatre. The mall is famous for its stunning architecture and the beautiful library, making it a popular destination for both locals and tourists. Our Farewell Dinner this evening will feature a Premium Seafood Buffet Dinner.

Day 10 **Apr 5

Seoul → Honolulu

(B)

After breakfast, we will visit Yeouido Island, a large island in the Han River. Every April, the Cherry Blossom Festival is held in the streets of Yeouido. Then, we will visit Gwangjang Market. Gwangjang Market was the first permanent market in Korea and continues to thrive as a popular tourist destination today. The second floor of the market is filled with silk, satin, and linen bed-sheet stores, which are the largest and most famous in Seoul. We can enjoy our own lunch here. Last, we will visit a famous Kimchi Making Facility and try our hand at Kimchi Making (D.I.Y). You will also have an enjoyable time trying on Hanbok (traditional costume). In the evening, we will transfer to the airport for our return flight home ending our fantastic journey in Korea.
