Day 1Apr 15**

Honolulu → Los Angeles

We start our vacation by boarding a domestic flight bound for Los Angeles. Upon arrival, we will stay overnight at the airport hotel.

Day 2Apr 16**

Los Angeles → Barcelona

We will begin our vacation by boarding an international flight from Los Angeles to Barcelona. **Barcelona**, the capital of Catalonia and Spain's second-largest city, is renowned for its rich culture and vibrant atmosphere. It ranks as the 10th most-visited city globally and the third in Europe, after London and Paris, attracting millions of tourists each year. Famous for its iconic Las Ramblas, Barcelona is the most popular city for visitors in Spain. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane during our journey.

Day 3Apr 17**

Barcelona

(D)

Upon arrival in Barcelona, we will proceed through customs, complete immigration formalities, and collect our baggage. An Air and Sea Travel representative will greet us and transfer us to our hotel. Dinner is arranged for this evening at the hotel.

Day 4Apr 18**

Barcelona

(B, L)

After enjoying breakfast at our hotel, we will begin our journey with a visit to the **Sagrada Familia**, a magnificent Roman Catholic church designed by Antoni Gaudí. Though still under construction, it is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, featuring three grand facades: the Nativity facade to the East, the Passion facade to the West, and the Glory facade to the South. Next, we will drive by the **Olympic Stadium**, which hosted the 1992 Summer Olympics. Following this, we will visit **Park Güell**, an architectural marvel created between 1900 and 1914, recognized as one of the largest architectural works in Southern Europe and part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site "Works of Antoni Gaudí." Afterward, we will transfer to **Casa Milà**, also known as La Pedrera, the last civil work designed by Gaudí, constructed between 1906 and 1910. This site was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1984. Finally, we will pass by the **Batló House**, built by Gaudí in 1904 and famously known as the "Block of Discord." This stunning structure was recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005 for its beauty and its spectacular, colorful, undulating forms. It's a must-see for any visitor and offers fantastic photo opportunities during our time in Barcelona.

Day 5Apr 19**

Barcelona – Zaragoza

(B, D)

Today, we will transfer to **Zaragoza**, an ancient city with a history spanning over 2,000 years. Located in the heart of the region, Zaragoza boasts a diverse landscape that includes deserts, thick forests, meadows, and mountains. Notably, it hosted Expo 2008 during the summer. Upon our arrival, we will visit the baroque-style **Basilica Cathedral of Our Lady of the Pillar**, a significant Roman Catholic Church. This basilica honors the Blessed Virgin Mary under her title, Our Lady of the Pillar, who is recognized as the Mother of the Hispanic People by Pope John Paul II. It is reputed to be the first church dedicated to Mary in history.

Day 6Apr 20**

Zaragoza – Segovia – Madrid

(B, L)

After breakfast, we will transfer to the historic old town of **Segovia**, a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1985, known for its remarkable Aqueduct. Our first stop will be the **Alcazar**, a stunning stone castle shaped like the "bow of a ship." Originally built as a fortress, the Alcazar has also served as a prison, a Royal Artillery College,

and a military academy. Interestingly, this castle inspired Walt Disney's "Cinderella Castle." For lunch, we will savor traditional **Spanish Roast Suckling Pig**. Afterward, we'll admire the impressive **Roman Aqueduct**, another UNESCO World Heritage site. This ancient engineering marvel was crucial for transporting water, sustaining a population of over a million in ancient Rome with its efficient "water extravagant economy," which supplied water for public baths and more. Finally, we will transfer to **Madrid** for an overnight stay. Madrid, the capital and largest city of Spain, awaits us with its vibrant culture and history. Tonight, we can enjoy our own dinner at nearby restaurants and take some time to explore the city at your own pace. It's a great opportunity to experience local cuisine and attractions!

Day 7Apr 21**

Madrid

(B, L)

After breakfast, we will have a visit to **Madrid bullfighting ring**, also known as Las Ventas, which is the largest bullfighting ring in Spain. Las Ventas is the largest bullring in Spain, so despite being a bit out of the center, it is worth a look for the impressive architecture. Then, we will visit one of the most renowned sites in the world: the **Prado Museum**. This museum boasts an exceptional collection of European and Spanish art, dating back to the 12th century. It currently houses approximately 7,600 paintings, 1,000 sculptures, 4,800 prints, and 8,200 drawings. Next, we will enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour, which will include **Plaza Mayor**. This grand arcaded square, located in the heart of Madrid, is a favorite among both tourists and locals. Its symmetrical design and uniform architecture are reminiscent of the contemporary Place des Vosges in Paris. We will then head to **Plaza de Espana**, bordered by two of Madrid's tallest skyscrapers. Historically, this plaza was a site of significance during the French occupation, where prisoners were executed during the May 2nd uprising. Here, we will see notable monuments, including the Cervantes Monument and various statues. Our final stop will be the **Royal Palace of Madrid** (Puerto Del Sol), the former residence of the Spanish royal family. Built in the classical Italian Baroque style in the 18th century, it stands on the site of an ancient alcazar (Arab fortress) and is regarded as one of the most beautiful and well-preserved palaces in Europe.

Day 8Apr 22**

Madrid – Granada

(B, D)

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Granada**. The city **Granada** is located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada Mountains, which famously hosted the 1996 World Ski Championships. As the 13th largest urban area in Spain, Granada offers a unique blend of history and culture. Today's highlight is the **Alhambra Palace**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site dating back to the 14th century. Marvel at its stunning Moorish architecture, intricate filigree, serene courtyards, and impressive walls. We will visit the **Generalife**, meaning "garden of the architect." Originally an architect's residence, it was later transformed for the Arab kings. The gardens are celebrated for their beautiful plants, the soothing sounds of water, and the interplay of light. After our exploration, we will check-in to our hotel in Granada and enjoy the dinner at the hotel.

Day 9Apr 23**

Granada – Seville

(B, L)

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Seville**, the fourth largest city in Spain, renowned for its three UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Upon arrival, we will partake a delightful **Spanish cooking class**. This hands-on experience will immerse you in the rich culinary traditions of Spain, focusing on regional dishes and techniques. Learn how to make **Sangria**, one of the most popular drinks in Spain, perfect for complementing your meal. After the class, enjoy a communal lunch featuring the dishes you prepared. This is a wonderful opportunity to relax, share your culinary creations, and savor the authentic flavors of Spain. Spain is the world's largest producer of olive oil, making up a significant portion of global production and serving as a major exporter. The country has a rich history of olive cultivation that dates back thousands of years, with a focus on producing high-quality extra virgin

olive oil. We will visit an **olive oil farm at Hacienda Guzmán**. With over five centuries of tradition in olive oil production, Hacienda Guzmán offers exquisite culinary experiences for those who appreciate the finer things in life. During our visit, we will participate in an **olive oil tasting** and have the opportunity to purchase some special olive oil to take home. Then, we will visit **Plaza de España**, also known as Spain Square. This iconic location featured in the 1962 film "Lawrence of Arabia" and served as a backdrop in "Star Wars." The plaza houses government departments and offers picturesque "Alcoves of the Provinces" for memorable photos. Next, we will visit one of the most popular UNESCO World Heritage Sites in Seville, **The Cathedral and Giralda Tower**. This magnificent cathedral is not only a stunning example of Gothic architecture but also the final resting place of Christopher Columbus. Originally an ancient minaret from the Great Mosque, the Giralda Tower, known as "La Giralda," serves as the bell tower of the cathedral. Climbing its 34 levels rewards you with one of the best views of Seville, offering a breathtaking panorama of the city and the Guadalquivir River that divides it into two parts. After that, we will check-in to our hotel and enjoy the rest of night on our own.

Day 10Apr 24**

Seville

(B, D)

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Jerez de la Frontera** to attend a captivating **equestrian show next**. This performance showcases the impressive skills of Andalusian horses and the artistry of their riders, highlighting traditional Spanish equestrian techniques. The show reflects the rich equestrian heritage of the region and promises an unforgettable experience, blending culture, music, and stunning horsemanship. After that, we will head to a **Winery in Bodegas Fundador**. Embracing the pagowine philosophy, combines tradition, technique, and expertise to produce exceptional wines. Here, we will learn about their meticulous grape selection and early elaboration processes, ensuring the highest quality. Enjoy a guided tour of the winery, where we'll gain insights into the art of winemaking and the unique characteristics of their wines. In the late afternoon, enjoy some leisure time on own. Tonight, **a traditional Flamenco dinner and show** is arranged. Enjoy music, dance, dinner and drinks.

Day 11Apr 25**

Seville – Lisbon

(B, D)

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Lisbon**, the capital and largest city of Portugal. As the westernmost city in continental Europe, Lisbon boasts a population of approximately 2.7 million people, making it the 11th most populous urban area in the European Union. Recognized as a global city, Lisbon plays a significant role in finance, media, entertainment, international trade, and tourism. Let's view the **Belem Tower**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This historic tower, also known as the Tower of St. Vincent, played a crucial role in Portugal's maritime discoveries during the "Age of Discoveries." Commissioned by King John II, it was constructed in the early 16th century and offers a picturesque photo opportunity. Then, we will make a special stop at the **Fábrica dos Pastéis de Belém**, one of the most famous bakeries in Portugal. Here, we can indulge in a freshly baked **Pastel de Belém**, a traditional Portuguese custard tart known for its flaky pastry and creamy filling. We will also have the chance to see how these delicious pastries are made. Witness the artistry and craftsmanship that goes into creating each Pastel de Belém, and learn about the traditional methods used in their preparation. We will be able to enjoy some **Pastel de Nata** before we return to the hotel. We'll have some free time to explore Lisbon at our own pace. We can check in our hotel. Afterward, **Baixa District** is a potential UNESCO World Heritage Site due to its pioneering example of earthquake-resistant construction. Here, architectural models were tested by having troops march around to simulate an earthquake. Stroll through tree-lined neoclassical streets filled with tailored shops and charming cafes in your leisure time.

Day 12Apr 26****Lisbon – Fatima – Lisbon****(B, D)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Fatima**, a civil parish in the municipality of Ourem in the Portuguese region. This area encompasses several villages, and the name "Fatima" is derived from a Moorish princess. Our first stop will be the **Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima**. At the entrance, we will see a beautiful mosaic representing the Holy Trinity crowning Mary, created by officials of the Vatican. The basilica features stained glass windows depicting the events of the Marian apparitions, and the fifteen altars within are dedicated to the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary. Then, we will return to Lisbon for our **Lisbon City Tour**. We will begin by marveling photo stop at the **Bridge 25 de Abril**, Europe's longest suspension bridge, spanning the River Tagus. Often compared to the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco, the bridge features an upper deck with six car lanes and a lower deck for two train tracks. Next, we will have the opportunity to view the **Statue of Cristo-Rei**. This monumental Catholic statue overlooks Lisbon and was erected to express gratitude for the Portuguese being spared from the war's devastation. Before our **farewell dinner**, we will enjoy shopping at the supermarket.

Day 13Apr 27****Lisbon – Queluz – Cabo Da Roca – Lisbon****(B)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Queluz**, a city within the Sintra Municipality on the Portuguese Riviera in the Lisbon metropolitan area. Queluz is renowned for being the home of **the Queluz National Palace**, which served as a residence for the Portuguese Royal Family. The palace is charming for its imposing nature and the exuberance of its architectural details, closely tied to the lives of three generations of royals and a backdrop for intense emotions. The National Palace and Gardens of Queluz captivate visitors with their grandeur and architectural splendor. The palace reflects the evolution of tastes and styles over different periods, transitioning from Baroque to Rococo and onto Neoclassicism. Continuing our adventure, we will head to **Cabo da Roca**, the westernmost point of mainland Europe. Here, you can enjoy breathtaking views of the coastline and the Atlantic Ocean. The cape, once home to a fort, rises 150 meters above sea level, offering stunning scenery. After our explorations, we will make our way back to Lisbon, where you can enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure.

Day 14Apr 28****Lisbon → Madrid → Los Angeles****(B)**

Today we will say farewell to Lisbon and transfer to the airport for our return flight home via Madrid, ending an amazing trip to Spain and Portugal.

Day 15Apr 29****Los Angeles → Honolulu**

Today, we will take a flight back to Honolulu, taking home lasting memories of this magnificent trip.
