**Day 1** Honolulu → Haneda

Our vacation starts by boarding an international flight bound for Shanghai via Haneda. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

**Day 2** Haneda → Shanghai

Shanghai is the most populous city in China. Due to its rapid growth in the last two decades, it has again become a global city, exerting influence over finance, commerce, fashion, and culture. Upon arrival, an Air and Sea Travel representative will greet us and take us to our hotel for check-in.

**Day 3** Shanghai (B, L)

The Bund is the Landmark of Shanghai, with many historical buildings along the river. All these buildings were used by government organizations a few years back. Now, there are many restaurants, bars, clubs and boutiques in them. This morning, we will explore the Special Economic Zone of Pudong and walk along the East Side of Huangpu River with memorable views of the Bund and PuDong (the new financial district). Then, we will transfer to the Bazaar or Open Market at the City God Temple. We can enjoy shopping for souvenirs or checking out food shops. After lunch, we can return to our hotel and explore the city on our own for the rest of day.

**Day 4** Shanghai – Suzhou – Shanghai (B, D)

After breakfast, we will take a day trip to Suzhou. Suzhou has over 2,500 years of rich history, and relics of the past are abundant to this day. Upon arrival, we will visit the Garden for Lingering In. After lunch, we will take a boat ride to explore the Grand Canal which is second only to the Great Wall as a Chinese ancient engineering feat. Because Suzhou is famous for its delicate and smooth silk and embroidery, we've arranged for a visit to a silk factory. We will return to Shanghai and enjoy our dinner before return to the hotel.

**Day 5** Shanghai → Xi'an (B, D)

In the morning, board a flight to Xi'an, one of the Four Great Ancient Capitals of China. Xi'an held that position under several of the most important dynasties in Chinese history. Upon arrival, we will check in to our hotel and rest. Tonight, we will attend the famous Tang Dynasty Dinner and Show that portrays the luxurious life during the Tang Dynasty. Tang Dynasty Show is based on the life of a famous historical figure in China: Empress Wu Ze-tian of the Tang Dynasty (618-90 AD). Empress Wu was born in 624 and became a concubine of the Tang Emperor when she was only 14 years old. Years of living in the palace made her tough and smart, growing up from a simple and innocent young girl into a hardened and sophisticated court politics player. With her wisdom, talents, and persistence, she managed to become the first wife of the emperor and in 690 ascended the throne to be the empress in her own right after her husband died. With a classical Chinese live orchestra and a state-of-art stage design, this five-part dance and music show will bring back to us the legendary Empress Wu Ze-tian and the glory and splendor of the Great Tang Empire.

**Day 6** Xi'an (B, D)

In the morning, we will visit a UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of the most exciting archaeological finds of the 20th Century – the Terracotta Warriors. The Terracotta Army or the "Terracotta Warriors and Horses" is a collection of terracotta sculptures depicting the armies of Qin Shi Huang, the first Emperor of China. It is a form of funerary art buried with the emperor in 210–209 BC and whose purpose was to protect the emperor in his afterlife. Archeologists estimate there were over 8,000 soldiers, 130 chariots with 520 horses and 150 cavalry horses, the majority of which are still buried in the pits. Then, we will go to Hui Ming Street, a vibrant and culturally rich thoroughfare located in the heart of Xi'an's Muslim Quarter. Known for its lively atmosphere, the street is a hub of culinary delights and traditional crafts, attracting both locals and tourists alike. We can enjoy our own lunch here. Then, we will have an orientation tour with a tour guide and visit the City Wall - one of the few ancient city walls still standing in China. It refers to a defensive system used to protect towns and cities in China in pre-modern times. The system consisted of walls, towers, and gates which were often built to a uniform standard throughout the Empire. Then, we will return to our hotel and enjoy Buffet dinner at the hotel.

**Day 7** **Xi'an** **(B, L)**

After breakfast, we will visit The Little Wild Goose Pagoda, one of two significant pagodas in Xi'an. This pagoda, along with the Giant Wild Goose Pagoda and other sites along the Silk Road, was inscribed in 2014 on [the UNESCO World Heritage List](#) as the Silk Roads: the Routes Network of Chang'an-Tianshan Corridor World Heritage Site. Then, we will visit the Xi'an Museum, a prominent cultural institution. It serves as a gateway to understanding the rich history and heritage of this ancient city. For today's lunch, we will enjoy the local cuisine that includes [Dumplings or Jiaozi](#). It is considered part of Chinese Cuisine and typically consists of ground meat and/or vegetable filling wrapped in a thinly rolled piece of dough and then sealed by pressing or crimping the edges together. After lunch, we will return to hotel and enjoy the rest of day on our own. Datang Everbright City, where our hotel is located, features a design theme that offers a comprehensive consumer experience encompassing shopping, dining, entertainment, leisure, tourism, and business. Here, we have the opportunity to enjoy dinner on our own.

**Day 8** **Xi'an → Beijing** **(B, D)**

In the morning, we will fly to Beijing, the huge capital of China and an ancient city of great splendor whose history goes back 3 millennia. Upon arrival, we will check-in to our hotel and rest.

**Day 9** **Beijing** **(B, D)**

After breakfast, we will driver by Tiananmen Square, probably the largest and most magnificent public square in the world. We will then explore the Forbidden City, the largest and most well-preserved imperial palace and a [UNESCO World Heritage Site](#). This vast and exotic palace was brilliantly captured in the movie "The Last Emperor". Seat of supreme power for over five centuries (1416-1911), the Forbidden City in Beijing, with its landscaped gardens and many buildings with nearly 10,000 rooms containing furniture and works of art, constitutes a priceless testimony to Chinese civilization during the Ming and Qing dynasties. Then, we will visit the Temple of Heaven, a [UNESCO World Heritage Site](#). It is widely regarded as the noblest example of religious architecture in all of China. This is where emperors came to worship heaven for a bountiful harvest. The design shows that heaven is high and the earth is low and reflects an ancient Chinese saying: 'The heaven is round and the earth is square'. The Farewell Dinner features China's famous [Peking Ducks](#).

**Day 10** **Beijing** **(B, L)**

Today's highlight is the fabled Great Wall, a [UNESCO World Heritage Site](#), and a massive defensive structure built to keep intruders out. China has many things to see, but the one great wonder is the Great Wall. We can see it undulating for miles across the mountains. The scale of this wall must be seen to be believed—it is an awesome sight! After lunch, we will visit a Jade Workshop, where we will learn about Chinese jade culture. Then, we will return to our hotel and enjoy some shopping and our own dinner near the hotel.

**Day 11** **Beijing → Haneda → Honolulu** **(B)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport for our return flight home via Haneda, taking with us lasting memories of this wonderful trip to China.
