Day 1 May 25**

Honolulu → Haneda

Today, we will start our wonderful trip by boarding an international flight to Tokyo, the capital of Japan and one of the most popular metropolitan areas in the world.

Day 2 May 26**

Haneda – Yokohama

Upon our arrival at Haneda International Airport, an Air & Sea Travel representative will greet us and transfer us to our hotel in Yokohama.

Day 3 May 27**

Yokohama

(B, D)

After breakfast, we will start our adventure by visiting Yokohama, the second largest city in Japan after Tokyo and the most populous municipality in the country. First, we will ride the Yokohama Air Cabin, the first urban ropeway in Japan. This transportation service harmonizes with the city's landscape, designed as an advanced way to travel while enjoying stunning views of Minatomirai, enhancing the area's attractiveness. Next, we will explore the historical Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse, a complex that includes a shopping mall, banquet hall, and event venues. Originally the Newport Pier Tax Keeping Warehouse for customs products, it now offers a unique shopping experience. We will then visit the Shin-Yokohama Ramen Museum, founded on March 6, 1994, as the world's first ramen-themed amusement park. This venue allows visitors to savor flavors from renowned ramen shops across Japan without boarding a plane. The exhibition area provides insights into the history and culture of ramen, and today, we can enjoy lunch at the Ramen Food Course. Afterward, we will head to Minato Mirai 21, a seaside urban area in central Yokohama, meaning "harbor of the future." This area features many tall skyscrapers, including the Landmark Tower, which was Japan's tallest building from 1993 to 2014. Once a large shipyard until the 1980s, Minato Mirai has transformed into a vibrant city center along the water, boasting shopping centers, hotels, a convention center, an amusement park with relaxation facilities, hot spring baths, museums, and park spaces. We will stop at the Yokohama Chinatown before our welcome dinner. After dinner, we will return to our hotel.

Day 4 May 28**

Yokohama – Diamond Princess

(B)

This morning, we will transfer to Osanbashi Passenger Terminal to embark on the newly renovated Diamond Princess cruise ship. The ship features 700 balconies, perfect for capturing stunning landscapes and intriguing city skylines from around the world. As one of only two Princess Cruise ships built in Japan, it's no surprise that this unique vessel frequently sails to some of the most exciting vacation destinations abroad.

Day 5 May 29**

Toba, Japan

This morning, we will arrive in Toba, Japan. Ships disembark at 7:00 AM and embark at 4:00 PM.

Toba, located at the northeastern end of the Shima-hanto Peninsula in Mie, flourished as the castle town of the Kuki family who ruled this region from the 16th century. It was also a landing spot for visitors on the sea route to Ise-jingu Shrine and belongs to Ise-Shima National Park. We can explore the city on our own or join some optional tour.

Day 6 May 30**

Kochi, Japan

This morning, we will arrive in Kochi, Japan. Ships disembark at 9:00 AM and embark at 5:00 PM.

Kochi sits on the broad alluvial plain facing Urado Bay. This city in Shikoku takes its name from the great feudal castle that sits at its very heart. We can explore the city on our own or join some optional tour.

Day 7 May 31**

Miyazaki (Aburatsu), Japan

This morning, we will arrive in Miyazaki, Japan. Ship disembarks at 7:00 AM and embarks at 5:00 PM.

Boasting the second warmest temperatures in Japan, Miyazaki offers a playground of outdoor activities that take full advantage of its balmy breezes and aquamarine waters. We can explore the city on our own or join some optional tour.

Day 8 Jun 1**

Nagasaki, Japan

This morning, we will arrive in Nagasaki, Japan. Ship disembarks 9:00 AM and embarks at 6:00 PM.

For most travelers, Nagasaki is a symbol of the horror and the inhumanity of war. An estimated 75,000 people perished in 1945 when the city became the second target of a nuclear attack. Today, Nagasaki's Peace Park and Atomic Bomb Museum draw visitors from around the world. We can explore the city on our own or join some optional tour.

Day 9 Jun 2**

Busan, South Korea

This morning, we will arrive in Busan, South Korea. Ship disembarks 7:00 AM and embarks at 8:00 PM.

The second largest city in South Korea, Busan is your gateway to a fascinating land whose culture is a unique amalgam of old and new. Modern high-rise towers dwarf ancient Buddhist temples. The city's bustling business district offers a stark contrast to the serene grounds of Yongdusan Park. In short, Busan is a microcosm of South Korea, a nation whose startling economic success often obscures one of Asia's most sophisticated and venerable cultures. We can explore the city on our own or join some optional tour.

Day 10 Jun 3**

Kanmon Straits, Japan

Today is a Sea Day; we will pass the Kanmon Straits.

Day 11 Jun 4**

Osaka (for Kyoto), Japan

This morning, we will arrive in Osaka, Japan. Ship disembarks at 8:00 AM and embarks at 8:00 PM.

For centuries, Osaka was Japan's cultural and commercial gateway to Asia - the point of entry both for trade goods and, most importantly, cultural influences that shaped Japanese society. From tea to Zen, from art to science and philosophy, Osaka was Japan's contact with the great East Asian cultures that flourished in China and Korea. While overshadowed by Tokyo, Osaka remains Japan's second largest city and a vital commercial center. We can explore the city on our own or join some optional tour.

Day 12 Jun 5**

At Sea

Today is a Sea Day; we are heading to Yokohama, Japan.

Day 13 Jun 6**

Yokohama – Tokyo

(L)

This morning, we will arrive back at Osambashi Port which will end our cruise. After disembarking the ship, we will go back to Tokyo for a tour. Our first stop is Tokyo Skytree is a broadcasting, restaurant, and observation tower in Tokyo and the tallest structure in Japan. We will enjoy shopping at Solamachi, the large shopping, dining and entertainment complex at the base of the Tokyo Skytree. Next, we will head to Asakusa to visit the historic Sensoji Temple. The temple was completed by the year 645 which made it the oldest temple in Tokyo. After lunch, we will take a Water Bus to our last stop – Odaiba, vibrant and futuristic district in Tokyo Bay, known for its entertainment, shopping, and attractions. Then, we will transfer to our hotel in Tokyo and enjoy the rest of night on our own.

Day 14 Jun 7**

Tokyo – Haneda → Honolulu

(B)

After breakfast, enjoy our last-minute shopping in Tokyo. Next, we will head to Haneda International Airport for our flight back to Honolulu, ending our Japan Explorer cruise and land tours.
