### Day 1\*\*Sep 1

#### Honolulu → Narita

We start our vacation to **Singapore**. Start boarding an international flight bound for Narita Japan. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

### Day 2\*\*Sep 2

#### Narita → Singapore

After breakfast, we visit **Gardens by the Bay**. We don't want to miss **Supertree Grove**, where we'll find a cluster of iconic, futuristic structures designed to perform environmentally sustainable functions. Then, head to the **Cloud Forest**

**Dome** to see the world's tallest indoor waterfall and learn a bit about biodiversity. After lunch, we will visit the **Merlion Park**, to enjoy the impressive views of Marina Bay. Do not miss out on a picture-taking opportunity with The Merlion, a mythological creature that is part lion and part fish. Explore the **Civic District** of the city, passing by the Padang, Cricket Club, historic Parliament House, Supreme Court, and City Hall. Then, we will visit **Chinatown** and **Thian Hock Keng Temple**, one of Singapore's oldest Buddhist-Taoist temples. Tonight, we can have our own dinner at **Hawker Centre Singapore**, an open-air complex. Return to hotel after our own dinner.

**Day 4\*\*Sep 4** **Singapore** **(B)**

**Today, we will enjoy our free day in Singapore.** Spending a day in Singapore offers a wonderful opportunity to explore the vibrant culture and stunning sights of the city. We can enjoy a free day to visit iconic landmarks like Marina Bay Sands, but a highlight of our adventure will surely be Sentosa Island. There, we can relax on beautiful beaches, visit Universal Studios Singapore, and explore attractions like the S.E.A. Aquarium. With so much to see and do, our free day in Singapore, especially at Sentosa, promises to be a memorable adventure.

**Day 5\*\*Sep 5** **Singapore → Bangkok** **(B)**

We will enjoy our free time in the morning, and then we will transfer to the airport and take the flight to Bangkok. Exit to meet Air & Sea Travel representative, who will greet and escort us to our hotel. **Bangkok** is the capital and populous city of Thailand.

**Day 6\*\*Sep 6** **Bangkok** **(B, D)**

After breakfast, we have an all-day **Exciting Bangkok City Tour**. We will visit the most interesting parts of Bangkok, including stops at the **Grand Palace** and the holiest of all Thai Temples "**The Emerald Buddha Temple**" (**Wat Phra Kaew**) where the replica of Angkor Wat and the late Ayutthaya-style murals on the surrounding walls illustrate scenes from the Ramayana are included in the temple's compound. Then, we will experience **Tuk Tuk on the Road**, the local Bangkok transportation. After that, we will transfer to **Icon Siam Riverfront Mall** to enjoy our own lunch. In the afternoon, we will visit **Sea Life Bangkok Ocean World**, formerly known as Siam Ocean World, which is the largest aquarium in Southeast Asia. It features hundreds of different species displayed in exhibits that collectively hold around 5,000,000 liters (approximately 1,300,000 U.S. gallons) of water. This impressive facility promises an unforgettable experience, showcasing the diversity of marine life and engaging exhibits that will captivate visitors of all ages. We will transfer for our dinner before return to our hotel.

**Day 7\*\*Sep 7** **Bangkok** **(B, D)**

After breakfast, we will visit **Maeklong Railway Market**, a unique market located directly on the railway just down the track from the train station of Maeklong. A 120 km drive to the most colorful **Floating Market** in Thailand passing the largest source of Salt Production along the roadside of the highway. At **Damnoen Saduak** we will see boat people sell their wares from boat to boat or boat to shore. We will ride on a **Long-tail boat ride**. We can enjoy our own lunch here. After that, we will also visit **Samphran Elephant Ground & Zoo**, a unique attraction located just outside Bangkok. This venue is renowned for its impressive elephant shows and interactive experiences, allowing visitors to learn about these majestic creatures up close. In addition to the elephant performances, the zoo features a variety of other animals, including tigers, birds, and reptiles, making it a great destination for families. With its beautiful gardens and engaging activities, Samphran Elephant Ground & Zoo promises a memorable day filled with fun and education. The night ends with a **River Cruise Dinner Buffet** in Bangkok. We will return back to the hotel after dinner.

**Day 8\*\*Sep 8** **Bangkok** **(B)**

**Bangkok** is the capital and most populous city of Thailand. Founded in 1782 by King Rama I, Bangkok is home to more than eight million people. The capital's proper name is Krung Thep - the "City of Angels." After breakfast at the hotel, we can explore the city on our own and enjoy the local shopping scene.

**Day 9\*\*Sep 9** **Bangkok → Narita → Honolulu** **(B)**

In the morning, transfer to the airport. We will take a flight back to Honolulu via Narita, taking home lasting memories of a magnificent vacation.
