Day 1 ** Sep 3 **Honolulu → Haneda**

Our vacation starts by boarding an international flight bound for **Haneda**. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

Day 2 ** Sep 4 **Haneda**

We arrive at Haneda International Airport and overnight in the airport hotel in Haneda.

Day 3 ** Sep 5 **Haneda → Beijing**

In the morning, we will walk to Haneda Airport and fly to **Beijing**, the huge capital of China and an ancient city of great splendor whose history goes back 3 millennia. Upon arrival, an Air & Sea Travel Representative will greet and take us to our hotel. We can enjoy the rest of the day and explore the city on our own.

Day 4 ** Sep 6 **Beijing → Hohhot** **(B, L, D)**

This morning, we will transfer to **Beijing Train Station** to board the high-speed train to **Hohhot**. Hohhot is the capital and largest city of Inner Mongolia, serving as the region's administrative, economic, and cultural center. Upon arrival, we will visit the **Inner Mongolia Museum**, which provides valuable insights into the history and traditions of the Mongolian people, showcasing artifacts used by nomadic Mongols. After our visit, we will check in to our hotel.

Day 5 ** Sep 7 **Hohhot – Xilamuren Grassland** **(B, L, D)**

Today, we will drive to **Xilamuren Grassland**, the first grassland developed as a tourism attraction in Inner Mongolia, boasting the best facilities in the region. Every summer, the traditional Naadam Festival, featuring various activities, is held here. Upon our arrival at the grassland, we will be **welcomed with a ceremony**. In the afternoon, you can look forward to **watching horse racing** and a **wrestling performance**. Later, we will enjoy a **Mongolian-style finger meat dinner**, followed by a night of **Mongolian singing, dancing, and a bonfire party**. We will stay overnight in the **luxurious Chariot Yurt**.

Day 6 ** Sep 8 **Xilamuren Grassland – Dalad Banner** **(B, L, D)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Dalad Banner**, located on the southern bank of the Yellow River in western Inner Mongolia. Upon arrival, we will explore the **Chilechuan Cultural Tourism Area**, which offers a unique experience of Mongolian culture and stunning grassland scenery. This area includes various sections, such as the **Meidaizhao Monastery**, the **Chilechuan Grassland**, and the **Hasuhai Lake Wetland Park**, providing opportunities for cultural immersion, horseback riding, observing performances, and enjoying local cuisine and handicrafts. After our visit, we will transfer to our hotel.

Day 7 ** Sep 9 **Dalad Banner** **(B, L, D)**

Today, we will enjoy a full-day visit to **Resonant Sand Bay**, known for its unique natural phenomenon where the sand produces sounds reminiscent of automobile and aircraft engines—an intriguing mystery that remains unexplained. After exploring this fascinating site, we will partake in several exciting activities, including a **camel ride**, a **Mongolian-style wedding show**, and **sand sculpture displays**. Additionally, you can enjoy a **train ride through the desert**, offering a unique perspective of the stunning landscape. We will return to our hotel after dinner.

Day 8 ** Sep 10 **Dalad Banner – Erdos** **(B, L, D)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Erdos**, known as the hometown of cashmere. Upon arrival, we will visit the **Erdos Bronzeware Museum**, a thematic museum dedicated to the collection, display, and research of "Erdos Bronzewares." Located in the downtown center of the Dongsheng District, this museum is the first in

China to focus on the bronzes of ancient northern grassland nomads and holds the designation of a second-class national museum. After our visit, we will check in to our hotel and enjoy dinner on-site.

Day 9 ** Sep 11 **Erdos** **(B, L, D)**

Inner Mongolia is the homeland of **Genghis Khan** (1162-1227), the great leader of the Mongolian people. His Mausoleum, located about 71 miles south of Baotou, is a site of homage, housing his clothing as a tribute to his memory. This morning, we will visit **Genghis Khan's Mausoleum**. After lunch, we will drive through the **Kangbashi District**, an urban area of the prefecture-level city of Erdos. This district is known for its impressive civic square and monuments. In 2009, it gained international attention for having a population of around 30,000, which was considered small compared to the scale of its development, earning it the label of a "ghost city." Next, we will explore the **Yihe Ecological Park**, a scenic area designed to promote ecological preservation and sustainable development. The park features beautiful landscapes, gardens, and various recreational facilities that encourage environmental awareness. We will return to our hotel after dinner.

Day 10 ** Sep 12 **Erdos – Baotou** **(B, L, D)**

In the morning, we will transfer to **Baotou**, the second-largest city by urban population in Inner Mongolia. Our first stop will be the **Badekar Monastery**, a prominent Tibetan Buddhist monastery belonging to the Gelug sect. It is the largest Tibetan Buddhist monastery in Inner Mongolia and was designated a Major Historical and Cultural Site Protected at the National Level in 1996. Next, we will visit **Northern Weapon City**, known for its defense and military manufacturing. This area specializes in the production of weapons and military equipment and is home to several significant defense companies and research institutions that enhance China's military capabilities. Northern Weapon City plays a crucial role in the country's defense industry. After our visits, we will transfer to our hotel after dinner.

Day 11 ** Sep 13 **Baotou – Hohhot** **(B, L, D)**

Today, we will drive back to **Hohhot**. We will visit the **Zhaojun Museum**, which is dedicated to the historical figure Wang Zhaojun, one of the famous Four Beauties of ancient China. After lunch, we will visit the **Residence of Gurun Princess Kejing**, a Qing dynasty courtyard house that currently houses the Hohhot Municipal Museum. It is listed as a Major Historical and Cultural Site Protected at the National Level. Tonight, we will have the famous **Mongolian hotpot** and stay overnight in Hohhot.

Day 12 ** Sep 14 **Hohhot  Beijing** **(B, D)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Hohhot Train Station** for a high-speed train to Beijing. Upon arrival, today's farewell dinner will feature China's famous **Peking duck**.

Day 13 ** Sep 15 **Beijing → Haneda → Honolulu** **(B)**

After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our return flight home via Haneda Airport, taking with us lasting memories of this wonderful trip to Inner Mongolia.
