Day 1Nov 9****Arrive Buenos Aires****(L)**

Our journey begins in **Buenos Aires**, a city whose name translates to "fair wind" in Spanish. Known as one of the most fascinating cities in Latin America and the world, **Buenos Aires** enchants visitors with its splendid and varied architecture, featuring a mix of old Colonial buildings, French palaces, and modern skyscrapers. The city's vibrant nightlife and endless cultural options, along with the rich identity of the Porteños—who take pride in their European heritage—make it truly unique. Upon arrival, an Air & Sea Travel representative will be on hand to escort us to a **half day city tour**. Our first stop will be **9 de Julio Avenue**, the widest street in the city, it is possible to spot the **Obelisk**, the monument that symbolizes the city, and view the famous **Colon Theatre (Opera House)**, a masterpiece of architecture with superb acoustics. Then on to **May Square**, historical and political center, surrounded by the Government House or 'Casa Rosada', site of the national government; the Cabildo, historical building which was the center of the colonial political life; the **Metropolitan Cathedral** and the **Town Hall**, site of the city government. Then, we will enjoy lunch before transfer to our hotel. We can enjoy the rest of day on our own, or take a good rest in the hotel.

Day 2Nov 10****Buenos Aires → Ushuaia – MS Fridtjof Nansen****(B)**

After enjoying breakfast, our adventure begins with an early morning flight to **Ushuaia**, where we'll meet our hybrid electric-powered expedition ship, specially designed for sustainable cruising in polar waters. This bustling port is the capital of Argentina's Tierra del Fuego Province. Set against the magnificent backdrop of the Martial Glacier, Ushuaia is a contender for the title of the world's southernmost city. After a briefing from our Expedition Team, we'll have time to locate our cabin and explore the comforts and amenities on board.

Day 3-4Nov 11-12****Get Ready for Antarctica**

Cross the Drake Passage. On the two-day crossing through the **Drake Passage**, the Expedition Team will equip us with everything we need to make the most of our polar expedition. Visit the **onboard Science Center** and find out what lies ahead. Listen as experts talk passionately about Antarctica's history, the science beneath the ice, and the impact of climate change and plastic pollution. Learn how to make our visit as safe and as low-impact as possible and discover the Citizen Science projects we can join. There's plenty of time to relax, so unwind in the spa and wellness area, enjoy delicious cuisine, and meet fellow travelers in the Explorer Lounge & Bar.

Day 5-9Nov 13-17****Antarctica: Another World**

Experience Antarctica in all its natural majesty. Nothing prepares us for our first sight of Antarctica's immense, frozen beauty. Antarctica will fill us with wonder, surrounded by looming glaciers and icebergs the size of floating cathedrals. Perhaps the most surprising part of Antarctica is the silence. The stillness that reigns is broken every so often by the locals – the wildlife. Whales begin to arrive in greater numbers by December and January. This is also when the first penguin chicks hatch. Seeing those clumsy clumps of feathers running around is always a charming sight. Nature is king here and we are mere observers. Our experienced Captain will continually monitor conditions to create the best possible itinerary for our adventure. Rest assured that each day will offer something different and thrilling. Join the Expedition Team on landings and while ice cruising. Back on board, the Expedition Team will continue their lectures, helping expand your insight into the frozen continent. Over five magical days, experience this amazing world in a way that will stay with us for a lifetime.

Day 10-11Nov 18-19****Returning to Warmer Waters**

Heading back north across the Drake Passage. After five incredible days, we'll have experienced so much in Antarctica. Our head will likely be filled with a swirling kaleidoscope of special memories and impressions. The next couple of days will be a chance to reflect on our adventure to the seventh continent. As our mind tries to

conjure up the magical Antarctic scenery, now could be a good time to sift through your photos and videos to recapture a sense of its magnitude. Why not take the chance to unwind in the sauna, or enjoy a few relaxing spa treatments in the wellness area.

Day 12Nov 20**

Ushuaia → Buenos Aires

Our expedition cruise ends in **Ushuaia**, the main city in Tierra del Fuego, Argentina's southernmost province. From here, we'll take a flight back to **Buenos Aires**, but it doesn't have to be the end of our adventure. Upon arrival, we will be transferred to our hotel and enjoy the rest of day on our own.

Day 13Nov 21**

Buenos Aires

(B, D)

Today, we will enjoy a full-day tour in Buenos Aires. We'll explore the affluent neighborhoods in the north, visiting **La Recoleta**, home to the grave of Argentine icon Eva Perón, famous for its stunning **cemetery**. Next, we will visit **Palermo**, a spacious and beautiful park located in the heart of one of the city's most elegant areas. We'll also stop by **Plaza San Martín**, a lovely park situated in the Retiro neighborhood of Buenos Aires. Located at the northern end of pedestrianized **Florida Street**, the park is bounded by Libertador Avenue. Additionally, we'll visit **Galerías Pacífico**, a renowned shopping center in Buenos Aires located at the intersection of Florida Street and Córdoba Avenue. The Beaux-Arts building, designed by architects Emilio Agrelo and Roland Le Vacher in 1889, originally housed a shop called the Argentine Bon Marché, modeled after the famous Le Bon Marché in Paris. Here, you'll have the opportunity to do some shopping. This evening, we'll enjoy a famous **tango show followed by a delicious dinner at an Argentine-style restaurant**, where you can savor the rich flavors of local cuisine.

Day 14Nov 22**

Departure Buenos Aires

(B, L)

After breakfast, we can explore the city on our own until checkout. We will then proceed to the **La Boca district**, a picturesque neighborhood where Italian immigrants settled, famously known for Caminito Street. This vibrant street inspired the tango "Caminito" by Juan de Dios Filiberto. Next, we will visit the **San Telmo Flea Market**. This large indoor market features stalls offering everything from antiques to fresh fruits and spices. With its characteristic Italian façade and spacious interiors, the Mercado de San Telmo opened in 1897 to cater to the needs of the wave of immigrants arriving from Europe. While many stalls have been updated, the market still retains its original structure, with metal columns and beams, making a visit feel like stepping back in time. You'll find an eclectic mix of stalls selling food, antiques, crafts, records, and toys. The coffee stall here is said to serve some of the best coffee in town. An **Argentine barbecue** late lunch will be arranged for us. After our meal, we will transfer to Buenos Aires International Airport, taking with us the lasting memories of this wonderful Cruise to Antarctica.

In the event balance of payment is not made within the required time period, Air and Sea Travel Center reserves the right to cancel reservations and charge a cancellation fee.

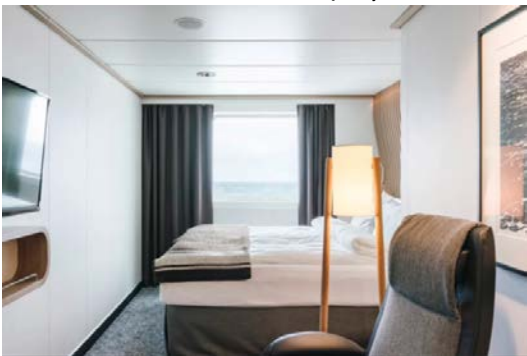
Cancellation Policy:

Written notice is required for any cancellation. The cancellation fee will be as follow:

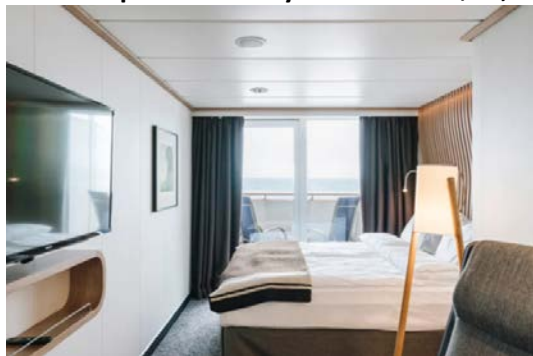
- ** **\$350** initial deposit is non-refundable after application is received.
 - ** **\$2,000** is non-refundable if you cancel after **Mar 1, 2026**.
 - ** **Jun 13 – Jul 12, 2026, 25%** of total price plus any other service fee caused from the cancellation;
 - ** **Jul 13 – Aug 12, 2026, 50%** of total price plus any other service fee caused from the cancellation;
 - ** **Aug 13 – Sep 12, 2026, 75%** of total price plus any other service fee caused from the cancellation;
 - ** From **Sep 13, 2026** or withdrawing during the tour shall be regarded as willingly giving up all rights concerned, **100%** of total price, and request for other services as a substitute/replacement shall not be accepted.
