Day 1 ** Nov 11

Honolulu → Haneda → Beijing

Our vacation starts by boarding an international flight bound for **Beijing** via Haneda. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

Day 2 ** Nov 12

Beijing

We arrive at Shanghai International Airport where an Air and Sea Travel representative will greet us and transfer us to our hotel.

Day 3 ** Nov 13

Beijing → Zhangjiajie

(B, D)

Today, we will transfer to the airport in Beijing for our flight, where we will be greeted upon arrival in **Zhangjiajie**. Zhangjiajie, home of China's first National Forest Park and Wulingyuan, a UNESCO World Heritage Site designated in 1992. Zhangjiajie is also one of the filming locations for the movie "Avatar." Upon arrival, we will enjoy dinner and check-in to our hotel.

Day 4 ** Nov 14

Zhangjiajie

(B, L, D)

After breakfast, we will spend the day in the **Tianzi Mountain Nature Reserve** and the **Ten Miles Gallery**. The Tianzi Mountains were formed from quartz sandstone 400 million years ago. These stunning sandstone peaks rise dramatically into the sky, often "drifting" among the clouds and thick mists. This area served as the inspiration for the floating mountains featured in the movie "Avatar." We will ride the **Bailong Elevator** up the side of a massive sandstone column in the mountain range. This modern marvel holds three Guinness World Records: it is the tallest outdoor glass elevator, the world's tallest double-decker sightseeing elevator, and the fastest passenger elevator with the largest carrying capacity. The **Ten Miles Gallery** is a 5 km road filled with various scenic views and attractions. It resembles an exhibition set in a gorge, inspired by a Chinese cartoon. Along the road, you'll find 200 peaks with names like The Old Man Collecting Medicine, Parents Holding a Son, and Three Sisters. We can enjoy the gallery by taking a mini train that runs on narrow railway tracks through the scenic area, providing a magical experience reminiscent of a movie world.

Day 5 ** Nov 15

Zhangjiajie

(B, L, D)

Today we will enjoy a full day at the **National Forest Park of Tianmen Mountain**. It has been called "one of the most beautiful mountains in the world" by many travelers who have been there. The stunning views including **'Heaven's Door' (Tianmen Cave)** and the **99 Bends (Heaven-linking Avenue)**, vertical cliffs, the thrilling cliff-hanging walkway and Glass Skywalk (Ghost-valley plank road), and **The World's Longest Cable Car Ride to the summit**, make it unquestionably one of the best mountains to visit in China. Come and climb the 'Stairway to Heaven'!

Day 6 ** Nov 16

Zhangjiajie → Chengdu

(B, D)

We will take a morning flight to **Chengdu**, one of the key economic, transportation, and communication centers in Western China. Chengdu Shuangliu Airport is rated among the top 50 airports in the world and is the most populated city in the region. Upon arrival, we will enjoy the famous **Sichuan Opera dinner show**, highlighting the incredible art of **Mask Changing**, a captivating performance that showcases the region's rich cultural heritage.

Day 7 ** Nov 17

Chengdu

(B, L)

Today's highlight is the **Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding**, a newly established home for giant pandas from the Wolong Panda Reserve, where visitors can admire these beloved animals in their natural habitat. We will also visit **Kuanzhai Alley** (Wide and Narrow Alleys), a historic area with charming shops and local eateries, perfect for experiencing Chengdu's rich culture. Afterward, we will explore **Jinli**, a 550-meter-long street that showcases Qing Dynasty architecture and is themed around the traditional folk customs of the Three Kingdoms Culture. Recognized as one of the "Top Ten City Commercial Pedestrian Streets," Jinli offers a vibrant atmosphere. Dinner will be at our leisure, allowing us to choose from a variety of local restaurants or street food vendors to savor Chengdu's renowned culinary delights.

Day 8 ** Nov 18

Chengdu ⇄ Jiuzhaigou

(B, D)

In the morning, we will transfer to **Chengdu train station** and take a **high-speed train** to **Jiuzhaigou**. Jiuzhaigou Valley National Park was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1992 and a World Biosphere Reserve in 1997. Locally known as Jiuzhaigou, meaning "Valley of the Nine Villages," the park is home to about 110 Tibetan and Qiang families, with the nine villages scattered throughout the valley. Upon our arrival, we will transfer to the hotel, enjoying the beautiful scenery along the way. Tonight, we will experience the spectacular performance "**Eternal Love in Jiuzhaigou**," which combines traditional Tibetan culture with stunning visuals, set against the breathtaking backdrop of Jiuzhaigou Valley.

Day 9 ** Nov 19

Jiuzhaigou

(B, L, D)

After breakfast, we will head to **Jiuzhaigou National Park** for a full day of sightseeing. The park is absolutely stunning and ranks among the most beautiful locations in China. It is exceptionally well-organized and maintained, showcasing a simple, idyllic beauty that feels like a fairyland, untouched and pristine. The sheer magnitude of the waterfalls and their crystal-clear waters will fill us with positive energy. The lakes are breathtakingly beautiful, the air is clean, and the water is pure. Some highlights within the park include Panda Lake and Waterfall, Long Lake, Colorful Pond, Nuorilang Waterfall, Tiger Lake, and Multicolored Lake. Jiuzhaigou is particularly picturesque in autumn when the mountains, valleys, and lakes are adorned with vibrant fall colors. Warm days and cool nights create stunning vistas of saturated yellows, reds, oranges, and greens, beautifully contrasted with the blue lake waters.

Day 10 ** Nov 20

Jiuzhaigou

(B, L, D)

After breakfast, we will embark on our visit to **the Jiuzhai Tibetan and Qiang Intangible Cultural Heritage Museum**. This museum offers a deep dive into the rich traditions of the Tibetan and Qiang peoples, featuring exhibits on their unique arts, rituals, and daily life. It includes dedicated halls for heritage displays, in-heritor workshops for hands-on crafts like **Tibetan incense making**, cultural creative stores, and interactive experiences. Following lunch, we will transfer to the world-famous **InterContinental Resort Jiuzhai Paradise**. This luxurious hotel feels like a paradise from fairy tales, offering a unique experience in the heart of western Sichuan. The InterContinental Resort Jiuzhai Paradise is a five-star hotel housed in a stunning steel-and-glass structure, beautifully embellished with inspirations from local Tibetan and Qiang cultures. It provides an ideal space for relaxation and recreation. We will have the rest of the day to relax or explore the surroundings at our leisure within the resort. In the evening, we will savor a delicious **buffet dinner** at the hotel, featuring a variety of dishes to satisfy every palate.

Day 11 ** Nov 21

Jiuzhaigou ⇄ Chengdu

(B, D)

In the morning, we will take a **high-speed train** back to Chengdu. Upon arrival, we will visit the **Sichuan Cuisine Museum**, is a unique cultural and culinary destination located in Chengdu, dedicated to showcasing the rich heritage of Sichuan cooking. The museum features a variety of exhibits that explore the history, ingredients, and techniques of Sichuan cuisine. We can learn about the regional spices, cooking methods, and the cultural significance of different dishes. After the **cooking class**, we will have the opportunity to taste a variety of delicious Sichuan snacks, showcasing the bold flavors and unique ingredients that make this cuisine so renowned. We will check-in to our hotel after dinner.

Day 12 ** Nov 22

Chengdu → Shanghai

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport for our flight to **Shanghai**. Upon arrival, we will transfer to our hotel and enjoy the rest of the day on our own.

Day 13 ** Nov 23

Shanghai → Kansai → Honolulu
